

PRIVACY POLICY

Effective Date: July 1, 2026

1. Introduction

The purpose of this Privacy Policy is to outline the data processing practices carried out by Lengyel László (hereinafter: Data Controller) on this website. The use of the website and its associated services is strictly restricted to individuals who are 18 years of age or older.

2. Scope and Purpose of Processed Data

The Data Controller only processes personal data that is voluntarily provided by the Users.

Contact Form:

Processed data: Name, Email address, Message content.

Purpose: To contact the User and respond to inquiries.

Registration and User Account (Dashboard):

Processed data: Name, Email address, Phone number, Password (stored using secure, one-way encryption/hashing).

Purpose: To authenticate the User, provide login access, and securely display the projects assigned to the User (server and domain data, access links).

3. Local Storage (Cookies, IndexedDb, LocalStorage)

This website does not use marketing or analytical cookies, and no third-party tracking occurs. The site exclusively utilizes strictly necessary technologies for its operation:

ProtectedLocalStorage and IndexedDb: These are local browser storages used by the system solely to maintain the logged-in session and to remember the User's selected language preference.

Anonymous Statistics: The system records page view counts; however, this is done completely anonymously, without storing any personal data or IP addresses.

4. Data Transfer and Data Processors

The Data Controller does not sell or transfer personal data to third parties for marketing or commercial purposes. Data storage and processing are carried out with the assistance of the following Data Processors:

- Hosting Provider (database and website operation): Contabo GmbH (Aschauer Str. 32a, 81549 Munich, Germany).

- Email (SMTP) Service: To deliver outgoing emails from the system, the Data Controller may use an external SMTP service provider (e.g., Google LLC), which also acts as a Data Processor for the email routing process.

5. Data Retention and Right to Erasure

The User has the right to request the complete and permanent deletion of their personal data and user account at any time. To request account deletion, the User must notify the Data Controller via email at interceptorwork@gmail.com. Upon receipt of the request, the Data Controller will promptly delete all data associated with the User.
